Introduction:

The Top Two Questions of Christians

1. "How can I know God's will?"
2. "How can I be a success for God, others, and myself?"

Thesis:

Trust is the most important factor in... knowing God and His will for my life and Growing His Kingdom and myself as a steward.

There is a Cause and Effect to Trust

1. Cause - We trust God completely. v.1
 2. Effect - They will help you live a long and prosperous life. V.2
-
1. Cause - We trust God always. v.3
 2. Effect - God and people will like you and consider you a success. v.4
-
1. Cause - We trust God with all our heart. v.5
 2. Effect - He will clear the road for you to follow. V.6
-
1. Cause - We trust God forever. v.7
 2. Effect - This will make you healthy and you will feel strong. V.8
-
1. Cause - We trust God with all. v.9
 2. Effect - Then you will have more grain and grapes than you will ever need. V.10

Observations

1. These words are all-inclusive. no exceptions.
2. They precede the promise.
3. The promise is conditional.

Stewardship Statements

1. God is Trustworthy - He is worthy of our complete confidence. He is totally dependable.
2. God has Entrusted (placed within our care) the possessions, opportunities, talents, and time that we now experience. Therefore,
